We assist young adults aged 14-24 with career goals focusing on education and employment. Career Navigators partner with young adults to help them identify career paths, learn job readiness skills, and increase their education, leading to self-supporting employment and satisfying careers.

## What We Offer Participants

- One-on-one goal setting and personalized attention
- Career exploration and job readiness training through career workshops
- Paid/unpaid work experiences and on-the-job training opportunities
- GED classes
- Occupational skills training
- Mentoring
- Tutoring classes and school credit recovery
- Assistance with education/training tuition and supplies
- Job seeking assistance
- Leadership and entrepreneurial growth opportunities
- Supportive services
- Incentives for completing goals

## Applicant Qualifications

- US citizen or authorized to work in the US
- Aged 14–24 years
- If male, must meet Selective Service Registration requirements as outlined in the Selective Service policy
- Has parent/guardian consent if under 19
- If in-school youth aged 14–18, identifies as low-income based on family size
- Possesses one or more barriers:
  - ◇ Basic skills deficient
  - ◇ School drop out
  - ◇ Homeless, runaway, foster child/ward of the state
  - ◇ Pregnant or parenting
  - ◇ Juvenile offender
  - ◇ Requiring additional assistance to complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment
